There were some new faces at the meeting that had long wanted to attend a meeting. One of the biggest surprises for new attendees, lifetime members, and everyone in between, was the new garden bed full of Rhopalostylis species. Even expert growers can attest to the difficulty of growing the members of this genus in Florida.

As the tour progressed, the membership was treated to many palms that are difficult to grow and difficult to source. A few members were chatting about *Johannesteijsmannia altifrons* just before Dr. Rossi showed one off at the garden. *Chrysalidocarpus decipiens*, a palm that is difficult to grow, but very cold tolerant, was planted in a bed made completely of pea gravel to facilitate drainage.
